This document outlines the Terms and Conditions for the Honours Scholarship Program administered by the Australian Institute of Nuclear Science and Engineering (AINSE Limited).

You must read these Terms and Conditions in full. In accepting the scholarship benefits from AINSE, it is understood that you have read and agree to comply with these Terms and Conditions.

Accepting your Scholarship

Successful scholarship applicants will receive an official letter which details the scholarship benefit and payment. If you do not wish to go ahead with the scholarship you are offered, you should advise us immediately in writing.

Termination of Scholarship

The scholarship may be terminated if the recipient:

1. Ceases the project collaboration with ANSTO;
2. Withdraws from their honours degree;
3. Does not meet the eligibility criteria.

If the scholarship is terminated, the scholarship will not be reinstated.

Scholarship value and payments

The stipend is for the exclusive use of the student only and is not transferable to another party. A stipend of \$5,000 will be paid directly to the University upon receipt of a University tax invoice. The stipend is then paid to the student in accordance with your University policy.

Acknowledging AINSE Funding

AINSE requires acknowledgement of its funding support.

All successful scholarship publications including:

- research publications;
- conference presentations;
- theses; and
- other publications or documents about the research that is funded by AINSE

must include the following statement:

“This research is supported by the AINSE Honours Scholarship Program.”
